





On the third day of the Six-Day War Dayan received intelligence that the UN was going to force a ceasefire abruptly ending the conflict. IDF command suddenly realized that this just might be their only chance to take the Old City. Hurriedly a plan was formed. Mordechai "Motta" Gur was ordered to command the 55th Paratrooper Brigade and take the Old City. Gur knew what a massive order this was.

Surprisingly they met with less resistance than expected and hurtled themselves towards the Temple Mount. Suddenly a voice cried out on radios in bomb shelters, bunkers and bases throughout Israel.

The voice was Motta Gur saying the immortal words, "Har habayit b'yadenu"... "the Temple Mount is in our hands!"


