Aided by coalition air strikes, the Kurdish YPG militia may have dealt IS its worst defeat to date in Syria by seizing the town of Tel Abyad at the Turkish border and cutting a supply route to the jihadists' de facto capital of Raqqa. According to Reuters, the Pentagon called the Kurdish offensive a significant advance that could disrupt supplies to Raqqa and the flow of foreign fighters.

10 Traits of Effective Dads:

1. They keep their lives de-compartmentalized. They are the same man, husband and father regardless of where and when. This directly connects to the character of these men. None are perfect, but I would trust everyone of them with my kids.
2. They realize that their manhood and fatherhood is directly tied to their relationship with God. This means time in God’s Word, time in prayer and time with God’s people is an essential part of their lives.

3. If married, they uphold their wives as their number one friend and co-worker in life. They realize that loving their wives is one of the greatest things they could ever give their kids.
4. They practice the discipline of meekness. They exemplify the combination of humility and strength. Men need to be strong for their families not at their families. In these homes, yelling and abuse of any kind is never tolerated.

[It’s very powerful to say, “I was wrong.”]

5. They’ve tied their hearts to the hearts of their children. There is a very special God-given bond that they cherish and cultivate on a daily basis. This means they are always looking to create heart-moments with their kids, especially when it comes to sharing God’s love and truth with them.
6. They honor their child’s gender and unique giftedness. They raise their sons to be men and their daughters to become women.

7. They are great listeners and make themselves available for those “by the way” teaching moments and conversations with their children (Deut. 6:5-7).
8. They make their children feel special and believe in them.

Dr. Meg Meeker, on Dobson’s Family Talk, writes: as a senior in college, I applied to medical schools and got a rejection letter from every school. I thought my life was over. Since the age of 16, I lived and breathed thinking about

medical school. I planned no back-up option. I was staying at my parents' home so I had the opportunity to talk with my mother about my disappointment. She comforted me and told me to try again. She made me good food and made me feel better. I left one evening to go for a jog to clear my head. When I returned home, I went inside and heard my father talking to a friend on the phone in his study. This was odd, I thought, because my father was a quiet man and rarely talked on the phone. I decided to do what any nosy 21 year-old does, and I parked myself outside his study door and listened. I heard him say my name. I listened more carefully and then he said to his friend, "Yes, that's right. My daughter, Meg, will be going to medical school in the next year or two." His voice was firm and filled with resolve. I was stunned. What did he know that I didn't know? Had he made phone calls on my behalf or paid off someone at a medical school? Of course, he hadn't. My father gave me a much greater gift. When I heard him state that I was going to medical school, I knew in that moment that I would go. As a young woman, I reasoned that if my father had that much confidence in me—in the face of the rejection letters—then I could do just about anything. Now, some 45 years later, I can still hear my father speaking that sentence because it changed who I became. But here's the fascinating part—my father never remembered having that conversation. In the course of living our everyday lives, words that expressed my father's beliefs changed the course of my life. And he didn't even try to do that.

9. Mercy and grace are a part of their households. As sinners, these men know that we will always be dealing with offenses and trip-ups. This makes mercy and grace two of their strongest relationship allies. A saying we often come back to is, "forgiven and forgiving." In this regards, they take the lead in admitting when they are wrong and asking for forgiveness.

10. They take care of the fundamentals or basics (the list above:). If something seems out of place with your life and your family, there usually are some fundamentals in your life that are not getting done. That's why prayerful evaluation is a life-trait of successful dads. It's hard to re-calibrate your life if it is constantly in the hectic mode.
