

This past week, I was driving in the car with my family. As we were driving, my daughter started to fear that we would run out of gas and panicked a little. I asked her if she knew where the gas gauge is on the control panel, and she replied, "No." I then asked if she could see the control panel from the back seat, which she could partially see, but she didn't know which gauge was for what.

It was at that point that I asked a question, "Do you think you can trust your Ema (mom) and Abba (dad) to know what we are doing?"
