
### May 18 19 Mtt. 26.51-54 Cut Off an Ear



# Mattityahu (Matthew) 26:51

ָאֶחָד מֵהָאֲנָשִׁים שֶׁהָיוּ עִם יֵשׁוּעַ שָׁלַח יָדוֹ וְשָׁלַף אֶת חַרְבּּוֹ, וּבְהַכּּוֹתוֹ אֶת עֶבֶד הַכּּהֵן הַגָּדוֹל קִצֵּץ אֶת אָזְנוֹ. At that, one of the men with Yeshua reached for his sword, drew it out and struck at the servant of the *cohen hagadol*, cutting off his ear. *[Was he aiming for the ear?* 

# Slightly different description in other B'sorot/Gospel accounts.]

<sup>Lk.22.49-51</sup> When his followers saw what was going to happen, they said, "Lord, should we use our swords?" One of them struck at the slave of the *cohen hagadol* and cut off his right ear. <sup>Yn 18.10-11</sup> Then Shim'on Kefa, who had a sword, drew it and struck the slave of the *cohen hagadol*, cutting off his right ear; the slave's name was Melekh.

Intention in off cutting ear?

- Likely going for the neck!
- Stop the attack,
- save the situation,

- preserve the Kingdom revolution
- Protect the King

## Mattityahu (Matthew) 26:52

אָמַר אֵלָיו יֵשׁוּעַ: "הָשֵׁב אֶת חַרְבְּדָ אֶל מְקוֹמָהּ, כִּי כָּל הָאוֹחַזִים בַּחֶרָב, בַּחֶרָב יאבְדוּ.

Yeshua said to him, "Put your sword back where it belongs, for everyone who uses the sword will die by the sword.

### [A slightly different take in the other B'sorot, gospels]

<sup>Yn 18.10-11</sup> Yeshua said to Kefa, "Put your sword back in its scabbard! This is the cup the Father has given me; am I not to drink it?"

Lk.22.51 But Yeshua answered, "Just let me do this," and, touching the man's ear, he healed him.

<sup>Mtt 5.39-42</sup> I tell you, **do not resist an evil person**. If anyone slaps you on the right cheek, turn to them the other cheek also. And if anyone wants to sue you and take your shirt, hand over your coat as well.

Mtt 5.39-42 If anyone forces you to go one mile, go with them two miles. Give to the one who asks you, and do not turn away from the one who wants to borrow from you.

- We pray and do NOT resist evil.
- How do we follow Messiah and rightly overcome evil?

Mattityahu (Matthew) 26:53

שַׁמָא חוֹשֵׁב אַתָּה שֶׁאֵינֶגִּי יָכוֹל לְבַקֵשׁ מֵאָבִי וּמִיָּד יַמְצִיא לִי יוֹתֵר מִשְׁנֵים־עָשָׂר לִגְיוֹנוֹת מַלְאָכִיםי

Don't you know that I can ask my Father, and he will instantly provide more than a dozen armies of angels to help me?

Mattityahu (Matthew) <sup>26:54</sup> But if I did that, how could the passages in the *Tanakh* be fulfilled that say it has to happen this way?"

#### What passages?

T'hillim/Ps<sup>2</sup>41.10 Even **my close friend**, on whom I relied, who shared my table, has turned against me.

T'hillim/Ps 55.13-15 For it was not an enemy who insulted me; if it had been, I could have borne it. It was not my adversary who treated me with scorn; if it had been, I could have hidden myself. But it was you, **a man of my own kind, my friend**, whom I knew well. We used to **share our hearts with each other**; in the house of God we walked with the crowd.

<sup>Yeshayahu/Is 53.5</sup> But he was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was on him, and by his wounds we are healed.

So we overcome evil by the power of the execution and resurrection of the Messiah Yeshua. Just 50 days later, from Pesakh to Shavuot, Kefa/Peter launched the message that would transform the world: <sup>Acts 2.35-38</sup>Kefa stood up with the Eleven and raised his voice to address them ... Let the whole house of Isra'el know beyond doubt that God has made him both Lord and Messiah — this Yeshua, whom you executed on a stake! Turn from sin, return to God, and each of you be immersed on the authority of Yeshua the Messiah into forgiveness of your sins, and you will receive the gift of the Ruakh HaKodesh!"

[Those of us who sing the Siddur, we chant about the resurrection of the dead. I grew up with this chant as a noble, poetic hope.]

אַמָּה גְּבּוֹר לְעוֹלָם אָדֹנְי אַמָּה גָב לְהוֹשֶׁיעַ *A-tah gee-bor l'olam Adoni M'khi-yay may-teem a-tah rav l'ho-shee-ah* You are the mighty One, forever, Adoni. You raise the dead. You are mighty to save. וְנָאֵמְנַאַמָּה לְמָחֵיוֹת מְתִים *ערוּ*דָּ אַמָּה יִיִ מְחַיַּה מַמָּתִים *ערוּ*דָ אַמָּה יִיִ מְחַיָּה מַמָּתִים *V'neh-eh-man a-tah l'ha-kha-yot may-teem Ba-rookh a-tah Adoni m-khi-yay ha-may-teem* You are faithful to restore life to the dead. Blessed are You, Adoni our G-d, Who gives life to the dead.

He has saved us and called us with a holy calling...through the appearing of our Savior Messiah Yeshua. Indeed, He nullified the power of death and **brought life and immortality to light through the Good News**.

<sup>Matt 28.18-20</sup> Yeshua came and talked with them. He said, "**All authority** in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Therefore, go and make people from all nations into *talmidim*, immersing them into the reality of the Father, the Son and the *Ruakh HaKodesh*, and teaching them to obey everything that I have commanded you. And remember! I will be with you always, yes, even until the end of the age."

Overcome the evil in the world by making Talmidim/disciples [not merely believers.] Transforming lives! Reproducing yourself spiritually!

Summer launch, not summer campaign

From Peter van der Steur:

It was January, 2016, in Sarasota, Florida. There was a prayer campaign in a number of congregations.

During this campaign in January, 2016, JB preached at Beth Messiah, calling people to go out and do Jewish evangelism. The Lord poured out His Holy Spirit and fire and the people there wanted to go out every night to do evangelism and, scores of people responded to the Good News.

Sometimes people in malls would come up to them and say, "What must I do to be saved?". It was remarkable. It lasted about 3 months and the congregation found themselves unprepared to deal with such an outpouring and harvest. About 10 new people remained in the congregation from this outpouring after a year.

To be able to steward such an outpouring and such a harvest, certain key pillars need to be in place in a congregation:

- 1. It needs to be a praying and fasting congregation,
- 2. The congregation needs to have a discipleship culture (including mentoring and coaching).
- 3. The congregation needs to have a small group structure that can easily grow.
- 4. The congregation needs to have regular outreach and do follow-up.

Resist the evil in the world by making Talmidim/disciples [not merely believers.] Transforming lives!


But is there a time to resist evil by action? Politics?

If you say, "Look, we didn't know this." Won't He who weighs hearts perceive it? Won't He who guards your soul know it? Won't He repay each one according to his deeds?

Dietrich Bonhoeffer 1906 –1945) was a German pastor, theologian, anti-Nazi dissident. His writings on Christianity's role in the secular world have become widely influential, and his book *The Cost of Discipleship* has been described as a modern classic. Bonhoeffer was known for his staunch resistance to Nazi dictatorship, including vocal opposition to Hitler's euthanasia program and genocidal persecution of the Jews. He was arrested in April 1943 by the Gestapo. After being accused of being associated with the July 20 plot to assassinate Adolf Hitler, he was quickly tried, and then executed by hanging on 9 April 1945 as the Nazi regime was collapsing.

"There's always kind of a calming feeling, I tell folks, when I think of the Holocaust, and the tragedy of the Holocaust, and the fact that it was my ancestors – Palestinians – who lost their land and some lost their lives, their livelihood, their human dignity, their existence in many ways, have been wiped out, and some people's passports," Tlaib said.



"And, just all of it was in the name of trying to create a safe haven for Jews, postthe Holocaust, post-the tragedy and the horrific persecution of Jews across the world at that time. And, I love the fact that it was my ancestors that provided

that, right, in many ways, but they did it in a way that took their human dignity away and it was forced on them."

Townhall's Matt Vespa insisted. "It omits a key point here: the Palestinians sided with the Nazis." In fact, no historical evidence- from the Christian, Jewish or Muslim world ... or anywhere else for that matter – corroborates her account.

In late November 1941, as World War II continued, German troops had besieged Leningrad and had reached the outskirts of Moscow. A great many observers all over the world had expected the USSR to have collapsed under the weight of the attack ...

The United States was not yet in the war. When Hitler and al-Husseini met, both leaders clearly believed that Germany was going to win, and the bulk of their conversation dealt with what the Arabs should or should not do help bring that outcome about.

A great deal of evidence indicates that the decision to murder all the Jews of Europe had been taken [by the Germans] sometime during the prior six months.





Al-Husseini began the conversation by declaring that the Germans and the Arabs had the same enemies: "the English, the Jews, and the Communists."


