From the Minute Men who were out-manned and out-gunned by the British on Lexington Green and later that day at Concord Bridge in 1775, to General Washington and his ill-clad men enduring the harsh winter at Valley Forge in 1778, to the rocket's red glare over Fort McHenry in the War of 1812 to the blood-soaked fields around Gettysburg where brother fought against brother in 1863, to the Doughboys in the trenches facing sniper fire and mustard gas in WWI, to the scores of Sailors who died at Pearl Harbor, to the Soldiers who stormed the beaches of Normandy, to the Airmen who went on bombing raids over Tokyo, to the Marines who fought on the shores of Iwo Jima, on the frigid hills of Korea, the jungles of Vietnam, the deserts of Iraq, and the rugged mountains of Afghanistan — these Patriots secured our liberty at a high price.



# **Getting to the text:**



### Mattityahu (Matthew) 26:55

אוֹתָהּ שָׁעָה אָמַר יֵשׁוּעַ אֶל הֶהָמוֹן : "כְּמוֹ עַל שׁוֹדֵד יְצָאתֶם בַּחֲרָבוֹת וּבִמַקְלוֹת לִתִפֹּס אוֹתִי.

Then Yeshua addressed the crowd: "So you came out to take me with swords and clubs, the way you would the leader of a rebellion?

[That was the Roman mode for quelling a rebellion: cut off the head.]

Mattityahu (Matthew) 26:55

ָהַרִי יוֹם יוֹם יָשַׁבְתִּי בַּמִּקְדָּשׁ וְלִמַּדְתִּי וְלֹא שְׁלַחְתֶּם יָד לִתְפֹּס אוֹתִי.


"But all this has happened so that what the prophets wrote may be fulfilled." Then the talmidim all deserted him and ran away.

Mattityahu (Matthew) 26:57

ָהָאַנָשִׁים אֲשֶׁר עָצִרוּ אֵת יֵשׁוּעַ הוֹלִיכוּהוּ אֱל קַיָּפָא הַכֹּהֶן הַנָּדוֹל וְשָׁם נִקְהֵלוּ הַסּוֹפְרִים וְהַזְּקֵנִים.

Those who had seized Yeshua led him off to Kayafa the *cohen hagadol*, where the *Torah*-teachers and elders were assembled.

Yokhanan 18.12-18 So the detachment of Roman soldiers and their captain, together with the Temple Guard of the Judeans, arrested Yeshua, tied him up, and took him first to 'Anan, the father-in-law of Kayafa, who was cohen gadol that fateful year.

Mattityahu (Matthew) 26:58

בִּיפָא הָלַדְּ אַחֲרָיו **בְּמֶרְחָק מָה** וּכְשֶׁהִגִּיעַ לַחֲצַר הַכֹּהֵן הַנָּדוֹל

Kefa followed him at a distance as far as the courtyard of the cohen hagadol;

Yokhanan 18.12-18 Shim'on Kefa and another talmid [likely Yokhanan] followed Yeshua. The second talmid was known to the cohen hagadol, and he went with Yeshua into the courtyard of the cohen hagadol; but Kefa stood outside by the gate. [Fearlessly identified with Yeshua]

Yokhanan 18.12-18 So the other talmid, the one known to the cohen hagadol, went back out and spoke to the woman on duty at the gate, then brought Kefa inside.

Mattityahu (Matthew) 26:58

ָנְכָנֵס פָּנִימָה וָיָשַׁב עִם הַמְשָּׁרְתִים **לִרְאוֹת מֵה יִהְיֵה הַסּוֹף**.

then he went inside and sat down with the guards to see what the outcome would be.

Not committed, just observing how it would play out.

Similarly, when there was a contention a few months later, after the great Shavuot / Pentecost:

[Challenge for us: are we in the Kingdom of Messiah on a trial run basis, see what happens, or are we committed to Yeshua as King?]

Acts 5.33-34 The members of the Sanhedrin were infuriated and wanted to put the emissaries to death. But one of the members of the Sanhedrin rose to his feet, a *Parush* named Gamli'el, a teacher of the Torah highly respected by all the people ...

Acts 5.38-39 "My advice to you is not to interfere with these people, but to **leave them alone**. For if this idea or this movement has a human origin, it will collapse. But **if it is from God**, you will not be able to stop them; you might even find yourselves fighting God!"

Not committed, just observing how it would play out.

Who was this man, Gamli'el?

Gamaliel the Elder also spelled Gamliel; רבן גמליאל הזקן "Rabban Gamliel HaZaken"; was a leading authority in the Sanhedrin in the early first century CE. He was the grandson of the great Jewish teacher Hillel the Elder. Gamaliel is thought to have died in 52 CE

In the Talmud, Gamliel is described as bearing the titles Nasi "prince" and "*Rabban*" "our master", as the president of the Great Sanhedrin in Jerusalem; although some dispute this, it is not doubted that he held a senior position in the highest court in Jerusalem.

Gamaliel holds a reputation in the Mishnah for being one of the greatest teachers in all the annals of Judaism: "Since Rabban Gamaliel the Elder died, there has been no more reverence for the law, and purity and piety died out at the same time."

#### **Shaul claims Gamliel:**

Acts 22.3 "I am a Jew, born in Tarsus of Cilicia, but brought up in this city and trained at the feet of Gamli'el in every detail of the Torah of our forefathers. I was a zealot for God, as all of you are today.

[No intimation in the Talmud that he became of believer, as some others of its bright lights apparently did! Eliezer.

Books on Non-Torah Talmud soon available, not authoritative, but useful]

Yokhanan 18.12-18 The woman at the gate said to Kefa, "Aren't you another of that man's *talmidim*?" He said, "No, I'm not." Now the slaves and guards had lit a fire because it was cold, and they were standing around it warming themselves; Kefa joined them and stood warming himself too.

[Non-committed, neutral to Yeshua > against Yeshua]

Mtt. 26.73-74 A little while later, some of the bystanders approached Peter and said to him, "Surely you're one of them, too — your accent gives you away." Then he began to curse and to swear an oath: "I do not know the Man!"

Not committed, just observing how it would play out.

It wasn't turning out well for followers of Yeshua.

"God doesn't answer prayer. He answers desperate prayer." I can still remember my feelings of shock and bewilderment as Leonard Ravenhill, the late church statesman, spoke these difficult words to me.

Of course, God answers prayer, I thought. But after much reflection I've come to recognize what Ravenhill meant: Often we approach prayer with the wrong attitude.

If we're honest with ourselves, we must admit that our prayers frequently degenerate into little more than religious incantations and shallow platitudes spoken out of a sense of religious duty. Yet the Bible compares prayer with the travail of childbirth.

It is, in essence, a passionate activity. I have found that it is often in times of desperation that I pray with a genuine passion to the Lord — a passion that allows no room for mediocrity or compromise.
