A subject of discussion among us.

There are at least 7 scriptures differentiating the Torah requirements of Jews and Gentiles.

Acts 15.1-2 But some men came down from Y'hudah to Antioch and began teaching the brothers, "You can't be saved unless you undergo b'rit-milah / circumcision in the manner prescribed by Moshe."

This brought them into no small measure of discord and dispute with Sha'ul and Bar-Nabba.

Acts 15.5 But some belonging to the party of the P'rushim / Pharisees who had believed stood up, saying, "It is necessary to circumcise them and to command them to keep the Torah of Moshe."

- 1. Ebionites Evyonim אביונים Gentiles keep all the Torah
- 2. Nazarenes Natsratim נצרתים נוֹצְרָי more nuanced approach
- 3. minority and majority,
- 4. minority comes back, Hebrew roots.

[First] Jerusalem Council

Acts 15.6-7 The emissaries and the elders met to look into this matter. After lengthy debate, Kefa got up and said to them ...

Acts 15.10-11 Why then do you put God to the test by <u>putting a yoke on the neck of the disciples</u>—which neither our fathers nor we have been able to bear? But instead, we believe that we are saved through the love and kindness of the Lord Yeshua, in the same way as they are."

[The yoke is what will not be put upon the new Gentile believers, that the Jews bear.]

What is exactly is the yoke?

[My thesis, main point of this message: The yoke was never precisely defined.]

Acts 15.19-21 "Therefore, my opinion is that we should <u>not put obstacles</u> in the way of the Goyim who are turning to God. Instead, we should write them a letter telling them to abstain from things polluted by idols, from fornication, from what is strangled and from blood. For from the earliest times, **Moshe has had in every city those who proclaim him, with his words being read in the synagogues every Shabbat.**

What exactly are the obstacles?

Two interpretations of these verses:

- Moshe has been read and little effect on Gentiles. Fugetaboutit!
- Moshe has been read, and now they'll get it and assimilate into Torah. But, timeline to do so? These are the alternative views of the Natsratim/Nazarenes. Evyonim / Ebionites demanded instant TOTAL adherence to Torah. This view was excluded.]

Acts 15.24 We have heard that some people went out from among us without our authorization, and that they have upset you with their talk, unsettling your minds [TLV some mss. add saying, "You must be circumcised and keep the law,"].

What talk, "unsettling your minds."?

Acts 15.27-29 We therefore have sent to you Judah and Silas, who themselves will report to you the same things by word of mouth. It seemed good to the Ruakh ha-Kodesh and to us not to place on you any greater burden than these essentials:

[Burden?]

Acts 15.27-29 that you abstain from things offered to idols, from blood, from things strangled, and from sexual immorality. By keeping away from these things, you will do well. [Later "Don't ask, don't tell about idol-offered meat.]

Acts 21.25 "As for Gentiles who have believed, however, we have written by letter what we decided for them to abstain from what is offered to idols, and from blood, and from what is strangled, and from immorality."

Vayikra/Lev 17. 13-14 "When someone from the community of Isra'el or one of the foreigners living with you hunts and catches game, whether animal or bird that may be eaten, he is to pour out its blood and cover it with earth. For the life of every creature — its blood is its life. Therefore I said to the people of Isra'el, 'You are not to eat the blood of any creature, because the life of every creature is its blood. Whoever eats it will be cut off.'

^{Gal. 2.7} On the contrary, they saw that I had been entrusted with the Good News for the uncircumcised just as Peter was for the circumcised.

Dr. Willitts' thoughts essentially state that there are two different gospels, not two different messages. Sounds confusing, however when it is acknowledged that the Gentiles' relationship to Torah is completely different than the Jews'. With the covenantal identity that exists for the Jew

within Torah also comes a covenantal responsibility to Torah. Whereas the Gentile is not obligated to Torah like the Jew is.

^{Gal. 2.14} But when I saw that they were not walking in line with the truth of the Good News, I said to Peter in front of everyone, "If you—being a Jew—live like the Gentiles and not like the Jews, how can you force the Gentiles to live like Jews?"

The yoke, the obstacles, the unsettling issues, the greater burden mean SOMETHING, but are <u>never clearly defined</u>.

<u>Covenant</u>: ^{1 Kefa/Peter 2.9} But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for God's own possession, so that you may proclaim the praises of the One who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light

<u>Real distinction</u>: Ro 11.12-15 Now if their transgression leads to riches for the world, and their loss riches for the Gentiles, **then how much more their fullness**! ... For if their rejection leads to the reconciliation of the world, what will their acceptance be but **life from the dead**?

That is, when a Jew comes to Messiah, and lives Jewishly, in Torah, community, there is a cosmic multiplying effect.

^{Zekh 8.23} Thus says Adoni-Tzva'ot, "In those days it will come to pass that ten men from every language of the nations will grasp the corner of the garment of a Jew saying, 'Let us go with you, for we have heard that God is with you."

[Dr. Michael Brown comment: 50 Jews in a Messianic synagogue >> 500 Jews in the churches.]

When a Jew comes to faith and assimilates into the church, in a sense, Israel is not saved. When a Gentile is saved and keeps Torah, they have great blessings, but no such multiplier.

There is GREAT power for Jewish people to serve the Messiah Jewishly.

Ro 11.11 Deliverance has come to the Gentiles, in order to provoke them to jealousy
