

The twenty released include 11 men kidnapped from the Nova Music Festival: Elkana Bohbot, 35; Rom Braslavski, 22; Evyatar David, 24; Guy Gilboa-Dalal, 23; Maxim Herkin, 35; Segev Kalfon, 27; Bar Abraham Kupershtein, 22; Eitan Abraham Mor, 23; Yosef-Chaim Ohana, 25; Alon Ohel, 24; and Avinatan Or, 32.

From Kibbutz Kfar Aza, Gali Berman, 27, and Ziv Berman, 27, were freed. From Kibbutz Nir Oz, the released include David Cunio, 35; Ariel Cunio, 28; Eitan Horn, 38; and Matan Zangauker, 25.

Also released were Omri Miran, 47, who was kidnapped from Kibbutz Nahal Oz, Matan Angrest, 22, who was kidnapped from the Nahal Oz outpost, and Nimrod Cohen, 21, who was kidnapped near the Gaza border.

Many of the hostages who have returned have testified that they were held for long periods in dark tunnels and subjected to torture, severe starvation, and physical and sexual abuse.

It remains to be seen IF Hamas will follow through on their commitment to disarm and disband.

Yasser Abu Shabab is a prominent anti-Hamas figure in Rafah. However, Hama confirmed that one of his senior aides had been "liquidated" as part of the operation. "The campaign will continue until no one violates the law," a Hamas security official said. The bloody effort to consolidate control highlights both Hamas's fragility and its determination to reimpose order amid Gaza's ruins —underscoring the deep volatility surrounding efforts to secure lasting peace in the enclave.

Naphtali Herz Imber was born into a Hassidic family. After receiving a traditional education, he left home to wander the world. In Constantinople, he became friends with Laurence Oliphant, a Christian Zionist, and went to Palestine1 with him in 1882. He had also become a believer in Yeshua. He was accused of "converting to Christianity" because of his constant poverty. However, he remained poor even after coming to belief in Yeshua, so the accusation is obviously false.

In 1878, he was inspired by the founding of the settlement called Petah Tikvah in Israel. He wrote a poem describing his feelings, and called it, Tikvatenu (Our Hope). This man set the poem to a melody based on a traditional Modavian-Romanian folksong called "Carul cu Boi" (Cart and Oxen). It was renamed HaTikvah (The Hope), and later became the unoffidal anthem for the nation of Israel.



**Reverend Thomas Robert Malthus** laid out in his 1798 writings, An Essay on the Principle of Population, a theory called Malthusianism.



Malthusianism is a theory that population growth is potentially exponential, according to the Malthusian growth model, while the growth of the food supply or other resources is linear,

which eventually reduces living standards to the point of triggering a population decline. This event is called a Malthusian catastrophe.

China's family planning policies began to be shaped by fears of overpopulation in the 1970s, and officials raised the age of marriage and called for fewer and more broadly spaced births. A nearuniversal one-child limit was imposed in 1980 and written into the country's constitution in 1982


Total Fertility Rate (TFR)

In July 2021, the Chinese Communist government removed all limits, shortly after implementing financial incentives to encourage individuals to have additional children.

The rationale for the reversal / abolition was summarized by former Wall Street Journal reporter Mei Fong: "The reason China is doing this right now is because they have too many men, too many old people, and too few young people.

They have this huge crushing demographic crisis as a result of the one-child policy. And if people don't start having more children, they're going to have a vastly diminished workforce to support a huge aging population."

# A similar population issue, but worse.

A landmark study published in the journal Human Reproduction Update analyzed data from over 40,000 men across North America, Europe, Australia, and New Zealand. The results were staggering – a 52.4% decline in sperm concentration between 1973 and 2011.

The authors warn that the mean sperm count has now dropped dangerously close to the threshold that makes conception more difficult, meaning couples around the world may encounter problems having a baby without medical assistance.

And the decline isn't slowing down. More recent data suggests the trend is continuing and possibly accelerating. But why? What's causing this dramatic shift in just a few decades?

The findings, published on Tuesday in the journal Human Reproduction Update, serve as "a canary in a coal mine," said Professor Hagai Levine, the study's lead author from the Hebrew University of Jerusalem's Hadassah Braun School of Public Health.

"We have a serious problem on our hands that, if not mitigated, could threaten mankind's survival," he said in a statement.

The study, commissioned by the nonprofit organization The Club of Rome, predicts that if current trends continue, the world's population, which is currently 7.96 billion, will peak at 8.6 billion in the middle of the century before declining by nearly 2 billion before the century's end.

Japan's population is projected to lose 18.7 million people between 2024 and 2050. The population is expected to shrink from 123.8 million to 105.1 million, a 15.1% decline. Japan's population has been falling since 2011 due to very low fertility rates (1.42 births per woman) and an aging population.

The population of Greece is expected to shrink from 10 million to 8.8 million, a loss of more than 12%, over the next 26 years. Greece's population began declining in 2011 when the first negative birth rate was recorded. Greece's population could decline by up to 50% over the next 50 years if nothing is done to combat it.


