



the Sept. for **רֹאֶה** *ra-ah* to feed, to tend a flock, keep sheep;
["Feed" is only one of the meanings, but maybe the most promoted.]

Rev 7:17 proclaims, "For the Lamb in the center of the throne will be their Shepherd. He will lead them to springs of living water, and God will wipe away every tear from their eyes"
[A key task of the Lamb, as shepherd, will be to quench the thirst of his people.]

¹ Kefa/Pet 5.1 Shepherd the flock of God that is in your care, exercising oversight not out of constraint, but willingly, as God wants; and not out of a desire for dishonest gain, but with enthusiasm.




He is the shepherd. Pharaoh Ex 5.2 Creator. Father.

Yn 10.14 Gives His life for his sheep

[Do we have a sense of Who our shepherd is?? Key to FEELING well tended.

Milky Way 100,000 light-years across, 200 billion stars

Andromeda nearest galaxy (2.5 million light-years) from Earth.

Alpha Centauri nearest star ~4 light-years 24 trillion miles.

One shepherd tells of neighbor sheep look across the fence.





Since October 7, 2023, 76 IDF soldiers have died by suicide. More than 300 others have attempted suicide. These soldiers survived Gaza. They survived Lebanon. They survived combat. But they couldn't survive what they brought home with them.

"My friends died."

"My nervous system is shattered."

"I saw horrible things."

This is moral injury. The deep psychological wounds from trauma, loss, and the horrors of war. The

trauma and PTSD these soldiers carry are just as real as any physical wound.
